## OBJECTIVE

This After-life communication plan aims to describe the actions that will be carried out to spread the results of the project BATInLoko – Environmental performance indicators and their relationship with economic factors in textile BAT implementation (LIFE 07/ENV/PT/000625), after project conclusion. These efforts will be performed by all project beneficiaries in order to guarantee the continuation of project activities and results dissemination to all stakeholders.

Dissemination activities will be addressed to the textile sector, industrial associations, scientific community, environmental agencies, nongovernmental environmental organizations, public authorities and students.

## COMMUNICATION ACTIVITIES

The main activities of the dissemination plan that will be carried out, once BATInLoko project is complete, will be the following ones:

### ■ Publications

- Publication of articles in specialized magazines
- News publications in partners websites and newsletters

All project beneficiaries will have responsibility in making publications.

### ■ Project website

The BATInLoko project website ([www.citeve.pt/batinloko](http://www.citeve.pt/batinloko)) will be maintained at least for five years after project conclusion and news will be updated. The information update will be given by all project beneficiaries.

Maintenance of project website will be CITEVE's responsibility.

### ■ BATInLoko webtool

The BATInLoko webtool will be used, by CITEVE, as a support for BAT implementation in textile companies.

Maintenance of BATInLoko webtool will be Minho University's responsibility.

The beneficiaries intend to translate BATInLoko webtool to English language.

- BATInLoko decision support manual

The beneficiaries intend to translate BATInLoko decision support manual to English language. The manual will continue to be distributed to all interested stakeholders by project beneficiaries.

- Environmental performance indicators

Results regarding environmental performance indicators obtained during project execution will be used by all beneficiaries, but in special by APA and ATP, in international meetings in order to discuss environmental policies related with textile sector, namely during textile BREF revision.

Regarding APA activities, since the MTD implementation is one of the premises of the IPPC Directive concerning integrated pollution prevention and control, new textile environmental permits will include the reference to BATInLoko project on the MTD chapter. The project and the developed software will be indicated as important tools for supporting the decision when analyzing the implementation of the MTD established in the BREF for the textile activity (Reference Document on Best Available Techniques for the Textile Industry).
